



# My Health eVet Quick Guide VA Microbiology



**VA Microbiology** is a feature of My Health eVet, found under the **VA Blue Button**. Here VA patients can view results of their **Microbiology** lab tests that were ordered by their VA health care team. This information comes from the Veteran's electronic VA health record.

You can use your **VA Microbiology** lab test results to partner with your health care team. Use this and other Information in My Health eVet to help your better understand your health and learn ways to improve your health and make informed decisions. My Health eVet is about Veterans taking charge of their health.

Your **VA Microbiology** lab results give you important information about lab tests you may have received at a VA facility. It also gives you important information about your health

To access **VA Microbiology** results in My Health eVet you must:

- Be a Veteran enrolled at a VA health care facility
- Be registered as a **VA Patient** in My Health eVet
- Have a My Health eVet [Premium](#)\* account

Use **VA Blue Button** to share results of your **VA Microbiology** report with your caregivers, non-VA health care providers and others you trust. This may help them better understand your health concerns.

If you have questions, you can use **Secure Messaging** to send a message to your VA health care team. Use it to ask about test results or ways you may be able to improve your health. In addition, you may also use it to set up a VA appointment or address other non-emergent issues.

*\*To get a My Health eVet Premium account, you will need to go through authentication. This is a process by which VA verifies a Veterans' identity before allowing access to their VA health record.*

Use the **VA Blue Button** to view, print or download your **VA Microbiology** reports.

- Log into your My Health eVet account
- Select **Download My Data**
- Select **Continue**

You can now select the **Types of Information**

- Choose **Select one or more types of information**
- Select **VA Microbiology**
- Select **Submit**

You can now select to **Download** or **View/Print** your information
